**Subject: Capacity building under the National Land Records Modernization Programme (NLRMP\_ Training programme by NIC/NICSI for the officials of Revenue/Registration/Survey/Settlement Department of the States/UTs and of the Department of Land Resources – regarding.**

Sir,

I am directed to inform that the National Informatics Centre (NIC)/National Informatics Centre Services Incorporated (NICSI), New Delhi has been requested to organize five days training programmes with two days of class room sessions and three days of actual field surveying under NLRMP on integration of land records and registration, cadastral maps, security and uniform coding etc. for the officers/staff in the Revenue/Registration/Survey/Settlement departments of the States/UTs. The main focus of the training is on the latest survey/resurvey technologies.

2. NIC has informed that the training will be conducted at the respective State/UT headquarters at the venue to be identified and arranged by the respective State/UT Logistics such as lunch, snacks, tea and coffee will be arranged by State/UT during the training while the faculty and training kit will be provided by NIC/NICSI.

3. It is therefore, requested that about 20 officers/staffs at the appropriate level from the Revenue/Registration/Survey/Settlement Departments of the State/UT may be nominated for the aforesaid training programme and the nominated officer/staff may also be directed to report to the venue of the training. The training schedule is attached at Annexure.

4. As NLRMP requires continuous training of Revenue/Registration/Survey/Settlement Department officials, this training by NIC will create a pool of master trainers in the States who can further train the people in the field level and local capacity building.
