Sub: Implementation of PFMS in IWMP

Sir,

A training of officials and experts from SLNAs was held at CGA-PFMS office on 2.12.2014 in which hands on training was given on registration of agencies at various levels under IWMP in PFMS. Questions and queries of the participants were also addressed. Registration of most of the SLNAs and some WCDCs was completed at the end of the training. Login and password for all the SLNAs was also provided to the participants from the respective States.

It is requested that further steps may be taken herein for implementation of PFMS in IWMP.

1. Registration of all the agencies ie. SLNA, WCDCs, PIAs and WCs should be completed by 31.12.2014.
2. To maintain proper mapping and hierarchy of the agencies, it is important that the WCDCs should be registered from the SLNA accounts whereas the PIAs and WCs should be registered from the respective WCDC account.
3. For this purpose it is requested to conduct camps in the district headquarters where all the concerned officials of PIAs and WCs may be called with registration details and where the registration of PIAs and WCs can be completed in one day after giving training to them. The officials of the SLNAs who were trained in Delhi on the 2nd of December 2014 should be the resources persons for this training. Help and cooperation of the local unit of PFMS may also be taken to undertake such trainings.
4. Any complication or problem encountered may be taken up with the officials at PFMS under intimation to DoLR. The following officials of PFMS may be contacted in case there is such a need.

The issue regarding registration of SLNAs of West Bengal, Punjab and Haryana is being taken up separately with PFMS resolutions of which shall be intimated to the respective states. The

subordinate agencies of these States may be registered as per the above procedure and timelines once their SLNA are registered.

SLNAs of Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh may verify at their levels the accounts of WDCs created by the DRDA and review if the mapped account details are correct and in use. Thereafter they may get in touch with PFMS under intimation to DoLR for correct mapping of these agencies under their respective SLNAs.

Progress in this regard may please be intimated periodically.
