

## Minutes of Pre-Proposal Meeting – RFP for ME&L under IWMP

1<sup>st</sup> October 2014, 11.00 am

Request for Proposals for Consulting Services for Monitoring & Evaluation and Learning under IWMP for five regions were issued to short-listed consultants on 18 Sep 2014 and the last date of submission is 17<sup>th</sup> Oct 2014. As per the RFP, the Pre-Proposal meeting was held on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2014 at 11. at Conference Hall, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, NBO Building Nirman Bhavan, New Delhi-11, which was chaired by Shri Amit Kumar, Director (WM) and attended by Asstt. Commissioner (TE) & M&E Expert and Procurement Expert of DoLR. The representatives of short-listed consulting firms, viz. (1) Nathan Economic Consulting India Pvt Ltd, (2) Remote Sensing Instruments, Hyderabad, (3) Mukesh Associates, New Delhi, (4) Gramin Vikas Trust, KRIBCO, (5) Sudha, Almora (6) WAPCOS Ltd, Gurgaon, (7) Vimarsh, Gurgaon and (8) AFC India Ltd, New Delhi attended the pre-proposal meeting. JPS Associates, Delhi communicated there queries by email. Director (WM) welcomed all the prospective bidders and briefly explained the role of Consultant for MEL under IWMP. Consultants raised various doubts and queries in a discussion mode and the Director (WM) responded to the queries .

The written queries submitted before and issues raised during meeting were discussed during the pre-proposal meeting and complied. The gist of discussions in pre-Proposal meeting is presented in following table:

Letter of Invitation & TOR Item No 3	Letter of Invitation states that ‘Separate Proposals for each region should be submitted’ and under ToR Item No 3, it is stated that ‘It is proposed to deploy separate agencies for <b>South, North, East, West and North East</b> regions separately’ Considering the above we presume that only one region will be given for one agency. Kindly confirm.	Please refer Item 2 of Corrigendum No 2 dated 2 <sup>nd</sup> October 2014.
3.	Letter of Invitation & TOR Item No 3	Letter of Invitation states that ‘ Each Technical Proposal should have separate team of experts’ We request to consider proposing some experts commonly for more than one region.	For Separate proposals for each region, requirement of separate teams of experts is obvious and essential.
